


**AT 14TH PLACE** in its overall ranking, China places in the third of four tiers for youth wellbeing. Of the nine countries in the Asia-Pacific region, China ranks 6th scoring only above Indonesia, the Philippines, and India. Chinese youth report their greatest optimism and satisfaction in economic opportunity and safety and security.
