


AT 10TH PLACE in the second of four tiers of wellbeing, Thailand is third among the Asia-Pacific countries, and highest in the upper-middle income group. Thai youth experience their greatest challenge in safety and security. Across the domains, youth are generally optimistic about their circumstances and future prospects.
